JUICY with a light crispyness




**WHERE** 

In Piedmont apples are grown mainly in the areas of Turin, Cuneo and Biella

The cultivation of apples in the Piedmontese valleys takes place in the range between 400 and 900 meters above sea level.

Around Novara apples are produced in the territory around the city and in the hills between the lakes Maggiore and Orta









The story of Piedmontese apple growing dates back to the Middle Ages, when the monastic orders cultivated and improved the varieties that had survived the barbarian invasions

For centuries apples have been a symbol of wealth, seduction and power They have played a fundamental role in many stories, in the Bible, in mythology and in fairy tales

## HARVESTING

Each variety is harvested at a different time; this can range from the 20th of September to the 10th of November.
